English Tasks

- Rewatch the 3 Little Pigs talk for writing video and retell the story to your siblings or grown ups - <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=WYjHX3aKW3M>
- Can you write the story of The 3 Little Pigs? See if you can include the words; first, then, next, finally etc.
- Can you draw a picture of what might use to build your house? Make sure you label it e.g. roof, windows, door etc.
- Ask a grown up or sibling to find different objects in your home. Can you name them and use your phonic sounds to write the word? For an extra challenge try to put the word into a sentence and use some tricky words such as: the, go, you, me etc.
- Watch Mrs Loosley's video of her reading the story 'Ruby's Worry' on the Mosaic YouTube channel. Can you think of any worries you might have? Have a go and draw what your worry might look like and write one or two sentences you can read to a grown up.

Maths Tasks

- Can you find different socks and pair them up correctly? Then can you work out what pair of socks belongs to who in your house? Can you think of a way to show how many of each kind of sock we have, so we can check that we haven't lost any? How would you record this?
- Can you play a game of 'What's the time Mr Wolf? Here is a quick explanation of how to play: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=bKYF7LnctQE>.

- Ask your grown up to show you different size coins. Can you find the 1p, 5p, £1 or 20p? For an extra challenge see if you can take two or three coins at a time and add them all together. How much money do you have? For an even bigger challenge can you write it as a number sentence? E.g. $1p+2p= 3p$ or $1+2 = 3$.

Topic Tasks

- Where did the Wolf from The 3 Little Pigs come from? Can you do some research about Wolves? Where do they live? What do they eat? Are the omnivores or carnivores?

Mosaic YouTube

We hope you are enjoying the videos on Mosaic's new YouTube channel. As the weeks go on we will continue uploading videos on a range of subjects including, Phonics, Maths, Jewish Learning and more. Below is some guidance on how these videos can be used.

1. **Phase 2 and 3 phonics/Phase 2 and 3 tricky words** - can be used daily and without adult input. If we were in school we would be reviewing these sounds and tricky words each day with the children. Children can also practise writing the tricky words independently.
2. **Number of the week** - complete each time there is a new number posted, can be used twice with children for practise. If you create the template for the children they may be able to do most of it independently.

3. **Maths topics e.g. 3D/2D shapes** - can be used once and then used as a quick recap. Adult input generally required.
4. **Phonics sounds e.g. ch phonics** - can be used once or until children feel confident with that sound. Please note children will often recognise the sounds such as 'ch, sh, ai' on their own but find it trickier to read these in words so practise is key! Children can watch this video independently but adult input required for any challenges or extra work.
5. **Story times and other videos** - use as often as you want! Children can watch these independently.
