## **English Tasks**

For the next couple of weeks, we will be looking at story writing. There will be a mix of analysis, grammar work, planning and the actual writing!

This week- analysis! All activities are on Seesaw with videos and prompts to help you!

- Day 1- How is a story structured and why? Answer the questions by replying to the activity on Seesaw.
- Day 2- Why do we need settings? BBC Bitesize helps us again! Watch the video, take the quiz and then answer my questions on Seesaw.
- Day 3- Audience and purpose. It's incredibly important to think about both the audience you are writing for and the purpose. Have a look at the videos and complete the questions. There are two activities for this one; questions appear at the end of the second activity.
- Day 4- grammar check! First person versus third person. The video is a bit old (possibly as old as me!) but it is very useful. Which would be better for your story? Have a go at the sheet too.

#### **Maths Tasks**

We will be continuing with the idea of angles in shapes followed by a bit of general problem solving this week. For each day, there is a video and a worksheet. Remember to ask me any questions you have. Only I can see your comments- no one else in the class can see anyone else's work unless I tag them.

- Day 3- Problem solving
- Day 4- Problem solving.
