## English Tasks

This week will be your chance to write your autobiography!

- Day 1- look at Seesaw! There is a list of features for writing an autobiography. Use this and the template to plan your autobiography. What are you going to include? Are you going to add some "fun facts" sections like in the biographies we read?
- Day 2- Let's write the first three paragraphs! I've created a video to show you how to transform the information from your planning sheet into the first few paragraphs of your autobiography.
- Day 3- Write the remaining paragraphs. Use the same ideas that you used yesterday to transform your planning into the remaining paragraphs.
- Day 4- use today to reread your work and make improvements. Can you make more interesting vocabulary choices? Have you repeated your word choices? Do your sentences make sense? Have you remembered the basics- punctuation, spelling?

## Maths Tasks
