This week, we are going to take a break from our curriculum learning and will be looking at a writing competition! Wimbledon Bookfest are working with the University of Roehampton to bring us a short story writing competition. The details are:

We invite your students to write either a short story or a poem on the theme of 'The Secret'. They are encouraged to be as imaginative as they like and take their inspiration from examples in literature – Jane Eyre, The Secret Garden, Chronicles of Narnia– or from their own experiences. We are looking for tales of any approach to 'the secret' be it about a secret place, a personal secret, trying to undercover a mystery, a secret club or a secret identity.

Stories or poems must be a **maximum of 500 words** and must have a **minimum of 100 words**. They must be typed in order to be submitted. I will choose the top three in our class and Miss Mauger will then send these to the competition. **Deadline: Friday 24th April** Email them to me or share in Seesaw.
