English Tasks



- Reading Eggspress: Complete reading comprehension, spelling and library book task.

Maths Tasks



- Seesaw: White Rose Maths Fractions, lesson 1 and 2
- Offline task: Play a board or card game with your family. Think about how many ways you used maths in your game. Did you have to count the total points or how many spaces to move? Did your game involve money, distance or shapes?
- Offline task: Write down your name in fractions. Write the number of equal parts in your name, what fraction represents each letter of your name, the fraction of vowels in your name and the fraction of consonants. You can upload your creation onto Seesaw.

Topic Tasks



- Purple Mash: Touch-Type activities (Practice keyboard typing skills)
- Purple Mash: Label parts of a plant
- Offline task: Keep a weather diary for 7 days. Record temperature, wind (look at trees and bushes outside for the intensity of the wind or look at the MET Office website), rainfall (create a rain meter using a 2L bottle of water and leaving it outside or check the MET Office website for information), how many clouds in the sky (their shape, colour and frequency). At the end of the week write down your findings. Some examples might be: it rained 3 out of 7 days, the highest temperature recorded was 17°C, I saw very dark grey clouds on Tuesday and Thursday.
