## English Tasks

- Can you write some words with the ai sound in? E.g. rain, pain, snail, paint. As an extra challenge see if you can write a sentence with one or more ai words using finger spaces, full stops and capital letters.
- Can you write two or more sentences about what you have been doing at home? As an extra challenge see if you can use first, next and finally or edit your work after you have finished (grown-ups please help with this!).
- Can you read a reading book from school? See which of our phonics sounds or tricky words you can spot in your book and have a go at writing them. You could use flour, sand, mud, talcum powder or anything else you find to write the sounds!
- Complete 4 tasks on reading eggs.

## Maths Tasks

- Can you complete one activity on White Rose home learning?
- Can you match numerals 0-20 to the correct quantity of objects? You might want to use cubes, pencils or anything else you can find!
- Can you watch Miss Shevlin's 2D shape video on YouTube and find some 2D shapes around your house? As an extra challenge see if you can find some shapes which were not mentioned on the video.
- Complete 4 tasks on Mathletics.

## Topic Tasks

- Design your own alien. As an extra challenge see if you can write some sentences about your alien. Where are they from? What language do they speak? What do they eat?
- Create a fact file about a planet of choice. See if you can write four sentences about your planet and draw some pictures.

## Mosaic YouTube

We hope you are enjoying the videos on Mosaic's new YouTube channel. As the weeks go on we will continue uploading videos on a range of subjects including, Phonics, Maths, Jewish Learning and more. Below is some guidance on how these videos can be used.

1. **Phase 2 and 3 phonics/Phase 2 and 3 tricky words** - can be used daily and without adult input. If we were in school we would be reviewing these sounds and tricky words each day with the children. Children can also practise writing the tricky words independently.
2. **Number of the week** - complete each time there is a new number posted, can be used twice with children for practise. If you create the template for the children they may be able to do most of it independently.
3. **Maths topics e.g. 3D/2D shapes** - can be used once and then used as a quick recap. Adult input generally required.
4. **Phonics sounds e.g. ch phonics** - can be used once or until children feel confident with that sound. Please note children will often recognise the sounds such as 'ch, sh, ai' on their own but find it trickier to read these in words so practise is key! Children can watch this video independently but adult input required for any challenges or extra work.
5. **Story times and other videos** - use as often as you want! Children can watch these independently.
