English Tasks

- Day 2- Listen to and read the biography again. On Seesaw, there are some reading comprehension questions. Please reply to the activity with your answers.
- Day 3- Listen to another biography with me! This one is about a Native American warrior called Crazy Horse. Compare the two biographies. What is similar about the two stories of their lives? Are there any major differences? Share your thoughts by responding to the activity on Seesaw.
- Day 4- more comprehension questions! You'll need to listen to both biographies again. Then reply to the activity to share your answers.
